The Project Development Objective (PDO) is to "add value and improve resilience of selected agriculture value chains focusing on smallholder farmers and agro-entrepreneurs in targeted districts of Assam." The project will achieve the PDO by: (i) promoting investments in agri-enterprises, reducing the business and transaction costs, facilitating access to finance for agribusiness entrepreneurs, and, where appropriate, push for process, regulatory and/or policy change; (ii) supporting the development of a modern agri supply chain; improved
- **2.** information communication technologies (ICT) based farm information and intelligence services, and alternative marketing channels; and (iii) improving producers' access to knowledge, technologies and infrastructure so that they are better able to respond to market opportunities and climate variability.
- 3. Under the proposed assignment, ARIAS Society now seeks to hire a firm or a consortium of firms for yield estimation at village level under APART.
